Exhibitor and Volunteer Camping Policy - 2011

Midwest Old Threshers - Mount Pleasant, Iowa

The Board of Directors for Midwest Old Threshers has established a new camping policy for all exhibitors and volunteers who camp on the main grounds or in the campgrounds during the annual Old Threshers Reunion. Under this camping policy, every exhibitor and/or volunteer will pay a flat \$25 fee for a camp site on the Reunion grounds or in the main campground. Monies generated by this policy will be used to maintain and develop camp sites, electrical service and restroom/shower facilities owned by the Association.

Exhibitor or volunteer with camper or tent placed on the main Reunion grounds: \$25

1. Fee is paid when the exhibitor or volunteer registers in their exhibit area or is placed in any of the main grounds camping areas.

Exhibitor camping in main campground in a tent, regular, or generator campsite: \$25

- 1. Exhibitor receives Exhibitor Camping Certificate from area director or coordinator.
- 2. Exhibitor registers in the campground in a tent, regular, or generator camp site.
- 3. When exhibitor checks out of the main campground:
 - A. Exhibitor shows camper registration and Exhibitor Camping Certificate at gate.
 - B. Exhibitor pays the flat \$25 camping fee instead of the regular camping fees.

Exhibitor chooses to camp in 30 or 50 amp camp sites instead of a tent, regular, or generator site.

- 1. Exhibitor Camping Certificate would not apply.
- 2. Exhibitor pays the regular fee of \$15 per night for the 30 or 50 amp camp site.

Individual volunteering more than fifty (50) hours prior to the Old Threshers Reunion: \$25

- 1. Volunteer receives a Volunteer Camping Certificate from area coordinator or director.
- 2. Volunteer registers in the campground in a 30 or 50 amp camp site.
- 3. When volunteer checks out of the main campground:
 - A. Volunteer shows camper registration and Volunteer Camping Certificate at gate.
 - B. Volunteer pays the flat \$25 camping fee instead of the 30 or 50 amp camping fees.

Individual volunteering less than fifty (50) hours prior to the Old Threshers Reunion: \$25

- 1. Volunteer with less than 50 hours would not qualify for a Volunteer Camping Certificate.
- 2. Volunteer is given an Exhibitor Camping Certificate.
- 3. Volunteer registers in the campground in a tent, regular, or generator camp site.
- 4. When volunteer checks out of the main campground:
 - A. Volunteer shows camper registration and Exhibitor Camping Certificate at gate.
 - B. Volunteer pays the flat \$25 camping fee instead of the regular camping fees.

Individual (with less than 50 hours of volunteer time prior to the Reunion) chooses to camp in a 30 or 50 amp campsite instead of a tent, regular, or generator campsite:

- 1. Exhibitor or Volunteer Camping Certificates would not apply.
- 2. Volunteer pays the regular fee of \$15 per night for the 30 or 50 amp camp site.

Free Camping Certificates can only be issued by the CEO for Midwest Old Threshers.
